
What is the Rural SafeGuard™ Programme

Desired Effect

- Deter the offender
- Detect suspicious behaviours
- Delay the attack
- Respond as planned

Each protective layer acts as a barrier between the criminal and the target of their attack; an effective barrier serves to Deter the offender from attempting their attack, Detect them at the earliest stage possible, Delay them for as long as possible, and buy time to initiate a pre-planned Response that avoids placing the victim in harm's way.

The best barriers will deliver multiple effects, at an affordable price, without unduly impacting those that live and work in the rural communities.




Collaborating with Police Rural Crime Teams


